



## Operating:

Round button to change light modes

Square button to change colour modes



- Remove pulsars from the charging case and place on the ground, an amber light will appear and the pulsar will start flashing. Lay the remaining pulsar on the ground and they will automatically synchronise with the flashing mode of the previous pulsar.
- The buttons on any of the pulsar can be pressed to change the colour modes and 6 flashing modes.
- Press the round button to change between the 6 flashing modes.
- Press the square button to change between the colour modes - RED/BLUE/YELLOW
- When you have the pulsars set up to the chosen flashing and colour mode, place all Pulsars back into the pockets in the carry case, ensuring the magnet is face down and the cluster of 4 LEDs is face up. The Pulsar are held inside of the pocket by the magnet. Now they are ready to be charged.

**Note: The pulsar lights will not turn off until they are replaced back into the case.**

## Charging - 10-12 hours charging time:

Connect the charger lead into the socket and connect the charger into a power supply (AC or DC), depending on the charger being used.



### Charging Indicator:

Red light = charging in process | Green light = fully charged

Once you have finished using the pulsar's fold the case back on itself so the pulsars are held in the case securely.

**Warning: Never use the charger if the leads, contacts or casings are damaged. Do not use any chargers other than those provided.**

## How to reset pulsars:

- Remove all NavStar pods from the case, and place them side by side.
- Switch off ALL NavStar pods using the 'round' button.
- On the 1st pod, PUSH and HOLD the square button (this will have to remain depressed during the whole process).
- The LEDs inside of the pod will flash back and forth RED-GREEN
- Once they become steady ON, continue below (still holding the square button depressed on the 1st pod)-
- Press and release the square button on each pod, 1 NavStar pod at a time so the LEDs commence blinking and go off.
- Once the remaining 9 pods have been programmed, release the square button of the 1st NavStar pod, and the LEDs will go off.
- Test all is reprogrammed:
- Pressing the round button on every pod, which turns all 10 NavStar pods on.
- Pressing and holding the round button on 1 pod, should switch them all back OFF.
- If any remain ON, they have not successfully been reprogrammed and the above process should be repeated for the whole set again.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION:

- Dropping the Pulsar NavStar may damage the battery or circuit components inside.
- IF THE Pulsar NavStar HAS BEEN SUSTAINED DAMAGE IT COULD BE A FIRE HAZARD. DO NOT USE THE PRODUCT.
- Place outdoors in a non-combustible container well away from flammable materials. DO NOT RECHARGE THE BATTERY AND CONTACT NIGHTSEARCHER.
- Never use the charger if the leads, contacts or casings are damaged.
- Do not use any chargers other than those provided.
- Always recharge the battery on a hard, flat, heat resistant surface.
- Avoid charging the battery in temperatures below 0°C or above 45°C and exposing the battery to temperatures below -20C or above 60°C.
- Never expose the charger to rain, moisture or damp. If you suspect any of these have occurred then do not use the charger.
- Always check with your airline before attempting to transport by air.
